The **FOCEP CBE** program consists of theory and practice. To complete the program, each student must:

- Have a minimum of a High School Diploma or GED.
- Complete the course of classroom instruction in FOCEP childbirth education.
- Observe a series of childbirth classes taught by an experienced childbirth educator or FOCEP preceptor.
- Teach one childbirth education class series with a **FOCEP** approved preceptor or instructor.

(It is also recommended but not required, to observe one cesarean birth.)

- Tour your local birth facilities.
- Attend a maternal child health community meeting.
- Pass the FOCEP exam with a minimum 80% score.
(Students may retake the exam one time if they fail)

Registration must be received by January 17, 2011

Payments must be received no later than the first day of class
